Sit**OLD TESTAMENT READING****Jeremiah 8:4-12**

“You shall say to them, Thus says the LORD:
**When men fall, do they not rise again?
If one turns away, does he not return?
Why then has this people turned away
in perpetual backsliding?
They hold fast to deceit;
they refuse to return.
I have paid attention and listened,
but they have not spoken rightly;
no man relents of his evil,
saying, ‘What have I done?’

keep the time of their coming,

ROMANS 9:30-10:4

What shall we say, then? That Gentiles who did not pursue Righteousness have attained it, that is, a Righteousness that is by faith; but that Israel who pursued a Law that would lead to Righteousness did not succeed in reaching that law. Why? Because they did not pursue it by faith, but as if it were based on works. They have stumbled over the Stumbling Stone, as it is written, *“Behold, I am laying in Zion a Stone*

of Stumbling, and a Rock of Offense; and whoever believes in Him will not be put to shame.”

Brothers, my heart's desire and prayer to God for them is that they may be saved. I bear them witness that they have a zeal for God, but not according to Knowledge. For, being ignorant of the Righteousness that comes from God, and seeking to establish their own, they did not submit to God's Righteousness. For Christ is the end of the Law for Righteousness to everyone who believes.
